### **Activating the Forensic Video Response Team & Digital Multimedia Evidence Processing Lab**

*Why submit a request:* LEVA's Digital Multimedia Evidence Processing Lab is the only deployable capability in the world that has been proven to efficiently process massive amounts of video evidence. LEVA certified personnel comprise the Forensic Video Response Team (FVRT) and have been trained to process evidence accurately and collaboratively so that investigative leads can be generated quickly.

*When to submit a request:* In the event of a significant local, state, national or international incident where an overwhelming amount of video and imagery is, or expected to be, collected. Priority is given to investigations involving acts of terrorism, threats to US Homeland Security, or threats to US allied interests.

*What does it cost:* The requesting agency will fund the travel, hotel, and meal expenses for the Forensic Video Response Team. The number of team members deployed depends on the anticipated amount of evidence. LEVA can scale the team size during an operation. A daily rate is charged based on location to cover fees for the lab infrastructure, FVRT Project Manager, Lab Assistant, and FVRT Operations Director.

*The cost benefit:* LEVA draws on a team of qualified law enforcement forensic video analysts. Experience has shown that providing irrefutable and timely video evidence can save the agency and courts millions of dollars in costs and significantly reduce potential litigation losses.
